- 5. (Acknowledge) I understand a background investigation will be conducted to determine my suitability to possess a state pistol permit and that process takes approximately eight (8) weeks.
- 6. **(Acknowledge)** I understand that making any false statements in the application is a violation of Connecticut General Statutes, and is punishable by a term of imprisonment not to exceed one year, or a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or BOTH a fine and imprisonment.

  Your email confirmation will provide you with the Service Code for the next step
- 2. Go online and complete the Connecticut Criminal History Check, Pre-Enrollment Application (CCHCPE) ADDRESS: CT.flexcheck.us.idemia.io/CCHRSPreEnroll

Fill out all mandatory fields. Once completed you will be prompted to pay by credit card the State Fee of \$75.00, the Federal Fee of \$13.25 and a Service Fee of \$2.65. (Total \$90.90) Following payment an **Applicant Tracking Number** will be provided which is mandatory at the time of your fingerprint appointment

### **Noncriminal Justice Applicant's Privacy Rights**

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
